This memorandum supersedes the December 9, 2014 deviation memorandum that implemented additional ODA auditing training based on Section 312 of the FAA Reauthorization Act, which directed implementation of Aviation Rulemaking Committee recommendations regarding ODA audit skills training. This memorandum removes the requirement for OMT members to attend the Facilitated Discussion: ODA Oversight course and allows aviation safety inspectors to attend both the Aviation Safety Inspector Job Functions course and the Quality System Audit (QSA) course in place of the basic compliance auditing training.

In addition to the existing training requirements of FAA Order 8100.15B, Aircraft Certification Service (AIR) and Flight Standards Service (AFS) personnel on OMTs or participating in delegated organization inspection program (DOIP) inspections must complete the following by December 31, 2017:

### OMT Leads and DOIP Team Leaders

- ODA Oversight: OMT Lead (electronic Learning Management System (eLMS) course, FAA27200088).
- Below applicable requirements for OMT members/DOIP participants.

AFS OMT Members and DOIP Participants

- ODA Oversight: OMT Member (eLMS course, FAA27200087).

AIR Aviation Safety Engineer OMT Members and DOIP Participants

- ODA Oversight: OMT Member (eLMS course, FAA27200087).
- Basic Compliance Auditing for AVS Personnel (classroom course, FAA28463).

AIR Aviation Safety Inspector OMT Members and DOIP Participants

- ODA Oversight: OMT Member (eLMS course, FAA27200087).
- Basic Compliance Auditing for AVS Personnel (classroom course, FAA28463) or both—
  - Aviation Safety Inspector Job Functions (classroom course, FAA21020, or earlier equivalent), and
  - Quality System Audit (QSA) (classroom course, FAA21415, or earlier equivalent).

The information in this memorandum will be incorporated into a future revision of FAA Order 8100.15.
